General terms and conditions of The Promised Land

Article 1: Waste

Garbage is to be deposited at the entrance to the campground. Please separate the waste:

- * Glass: in the glass container
- * Paper/cardboard: in the paper container
- * Bio waste in the green waste container
- * The other waste: only in a garbage bag in the large container
- * Batteries: in the designated bin in the hall near the cafeteria/toilet building.
- * Depositing bulky waste in the containers is not permitted.

Article 2: Wastewater

This can be emptied at the chemical toilet dump station next to the laundromat or at the Bath House on the left side of the toilet building.

Article 3: Alcohol & drugs

The , use or being under the influence of drugs is not permitted. The consumption of alcohol (18 years and older) is permitted only at one's own pitch or accommodation. Campers under the age of 18 are not permitted be in possession or under the influence of alcohol in public areas of the campground. We reserve the right immediately deny access to the campground to violators of this rule.

Article 4: Mopeds & Motorcycles

It is not permitted to ride the moped/motorbike on the grounds.

Article 5: First Aid and Rescuers & Emergencies

A first aid kit is at the reception desk. You can also go there for first aid. In the camping app you will find a complete and current overview of emergency service providers in the . In the unlikely event you a technical malfunction, you can Whatsap to 06-83904515. This number is available 24/7 for medical emergencies or urgent breakdowns of gas, water, electricity or noise. For medical emergencies, we would like to ask you to call 112 first. After the alarminform the reception desk or call the Whatsapp number outside office hours.

Article 6: Electricity connection

A pitch comes with standard 10 ampere electricity (2300 watts). You can connect lights, radio, TV and refrigerator to this. No household coffee maker or tea kettle can be connected to this power. The cable must have a rubber plug with euro plug (blue plug).

Article 7: Grass mat

Good turf is very important for camping. Do you want to spare it by not driving on the grass during wet periods than only in extreme necessity? Digging trenches or pits is of course "out of the question. Also, placing fences, netting or other fencing is not allowed.

Article 8: Pets

On the grounds, pets must be leashed and are not allowed in the buildings. Dogs will be walked outside the grounds. We count on you to clean up any "accidents". The address of the veterinary practice is V.U.G, Evertsenlaan 18 in Voorthuizen, telephone number 0342-471316.

Article 9: Church services

Services are held in Voorthuizen by different denominations. In the camping app you will find an overview of the different church services and times. There is also a service held at the campground at 10:00 a.m. in the large room "de Schaapskooi" by Christian Church the Open Hof. More information <u>openhof.info</u>

Article 10: Camping site

You must abide by the rules associated with standard, comfort and private sanitary sites. The rules in the explanation for pitches apply to your (seasonal) pitch and can be found on the website of the campsite. When you register your pitch, you indicate that you have read and agree with them.

Article 11: Mail

Mail intended for you will be put in the mailbox at the reception where you can pick it up. Want send a card to the home front? You will find the mailbox at the corner of Jan de Jagerweg and Effrinkstraat.

Article 12: Party tent

A small open party tent of 3x3 meters may be set up instead of an additional tent provided it fits and is allowed on the particular pitch. The party tent may not be closed with side walls. It must always be open.

Article 13: Sanitary facilities

We kindly ask you accompany children under the of 6 to the toilet building. At the sanitary building "the Well" there are special toilets on the side of the building for children. The washrooms with children's pool in toilet building "the Bathhouse" are reserved for fathers and mothers with children from 5 p.m. - 7 p.m. A hair dryer is installed in the ladies' area of the toilet building. You can also use your own hair dryer there.

Article 14: Barrier

On arrival and departure days the barrier is open from 08.00 - 20.00. We are a car-free campsite therefore our barrier is closed the rest of the week. You can only enter the site by car on first arrival and last departure.

Article 15: Playground & sports

No playing in the playground is allowed between 10:30 - 8:00 p.m. (for the sake of peace and quiet). Playing soccer, volleyball etc. etc. is only allowed on the designated sports fields.

Article 16: Silence and tranquility

Don't let other guests enjoy your radio. They too would like to the peace and quiet. Between 10:30 - 8:00 p.m. the quiet period, and between 11:00 - 7:00 p.m. we expect absolute silence. Please keep in mind that on a quiet site any sound is very penetrating? This way we all have a nice vacation with a good night's sleep.

Article 17: Chemical toilet disposal site

This dump site is located to the right of the laundromat and behind the restroom building on the new site.

Article 18: Open fire

Making open fires in fire baskets, fire bowls etc. etc. is permitted only in our designated areas at the forest cottages & at the petting zoo on the A site (Goat Meadow). Provided code 1 applies to the site www.natuurbrandrisico.nl. No fires are allowed at Phase 2 due to the increased risk of fire. BBQ'ing is allowed at the campsite.

Article 19: Setting up (inflatable) swimming pool

Setting up an (inflatable) pool near the pitch is not allowed except for small paddling pools up to 40 cm high.

Article 20: Swimming pool

The swimming pool is only open to campground guests. It is not allowed to dive into the pool, climb over the fences or inflatable air mattresses, toys, etc. when crowded. Sliding down the slide is allowed only according to the instructions on the sign by the slide. It is not permitted enter the pool area with shoes. Swimming in the pool is at your own risk.

Children without swimming certificates should the pool only when accompanied by an adult. Children up to 3 years of age may enter the pool only if a swim diaper. The restroom next to the pool is for guests swimming.

The pool is open according to the times in the camping app. The pool is closed after sunset. During thunderstorms guests should leave the pool. If you receive visitors, these guests pay€ 4.50 per person at the reception.
